

Companion Animal Clinic Foundation Updates

Thank you so very much for your support for Companion Animal Clinic Foundation and the Spay Neuter Veterinary Clinic in Vass, N. C. As a result of your contributions several important goals were met. In January 2016 the mortgage on the building at 5071 US Hwy #1, Suite C, Vass, NC was paid off! Other significant improvements were the addition of the 3rd surgery room in 2012, remodeling the break room and administrative offices, and replacement of the roof and front doors 2014. Furthermore, in 2015 the Spay Neuter Veterinary Clinic surpassed projected number of surgeries thus ending the year with 7566 and a total over 50,000 surgeries since opening in 2008. The mission to reduce euthanasia through affordable spay/neuter, although ongoing, has been provided a clear course to success in Central North Carolina through your donations.

The volume of surgeries requires continued equipment replacement by the Foundation. Goals for 2016 will include replacing some of our most used equipment. Two major equipment items requiring subsidy include a new surgery table (\$10,000) and an Oxygen Generator (\$15,000). Please keep these items in mind as you plan your giving for 2016.

We would like to extend an open invitation to donors to become involved in a variety of ways.
